How we're ensuring workers know how to keep themselves safe from exposure to COVID-19

### Physical distancing and separation

- Offer virtual physiotherapy to limit in clinic visits
- Plexiglass barriers are installed at the reception desk
- Chairs spaced out in reception and open treatment areas

### **Cleaning**

- Hightened cleaning protocols for patient treatment room, common areas and high touch points

### **Other**

- Increased technology including secure fillable intake forms, touchless payment and available online booking.
