Measures we're taking

How we're ensuring workers know how to keep themselves safe from exposure to COVID-19

Physical distancing and separation

- Plexiglass barriers are installed at the reception desk
- Chairs spaced out in reception and open treatment areas



Cleaning

• Hightened cleaning protocols for patient treatment room, common areas and high touch points

• Increased technology including secure fillable intake forms, touchless payment and available online booking.
